Beriti Giwe is a sub-village in Yirgacheffe, central southern Ethiopia, known for its amazing floral coffees. The picking season in Beriti is from November to the end of January.

Farmers deliver their cherries to local wet mills, the wet mill then delivers parchment coffee to a delivery station warehouse in Yirgacheffe called Dila. All this with help of the Ethiopian Commodity Exchange that helps farmers get the best prices according to the quality of the coffee.
